Constitution of UNIMA-CHINA

(Revised 5.11.2001)

UNIMA-CHINA is a branch of UNIMA, which is dedicated to puppet development. Chinese in the Mainland, Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan can join UNIMA-CHINA as a member. The only requirement is to pursue peace, understanding between races with puppet arts; respect the basic human rights stipulated by the "International Human Right Declaration" of the United Nations made on 10 December 1948.

UNIMA-CHINA will comply with all the rules and organize its life in accordance with

UNIMA's Statutes and Rules of Procedure.

1. Objectives and methodology

The objective of UNIMA-CHINA is to promote the development of puppet art. The methods to achieve this objective are:

- i. Organize members to actively participate in the meetings and activities of UNIMA.
- ii. Enhance the interaction of puppeteers between countries by ways of interchanging.
- iii. Organize members meeting and other meetings, Chinese Puppet Festival and exhibitions
- iv. Encourage training on academic research of puppet arts and professional quality.

2. Membership

- Any individual, in the Mainland, Hong Kong, Macau or Taiwan, engaged in puppet arts can join UNIMA-CHINA as a member.
- ii. Membership is classified into individual and corperate.
- iii. China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society is the key corperate member of UNIMA-CHINA.

3. Rights of member

- i. Members have the right attend the meetings of UNIMA and UNIMA-CHINA.
- ii. Members have the right to participate in the activities of UNIMA and UNIMA-CHINA.
- iii. Members have the right to be elected for the administrative posts in UNIMA and UNIMA-CHINA after paying member fees.

4. Obligation of member

- i. Uphold the objectives of UNIMA and UNIMA-CHINA.
- ii. Respect the constitutions of UNIMA and UNIMA-CHINA.
- iii. Pay membership fees promptly.

5. Management Structure of UNIMA-CHINA

The Management Structure of UNIMA-CHINA: Membership Meeting, Board of Directors, Finance Division, Standing Committee, Secretariat, Working Committees and Regional Centres.

6. Membership Meeting

- i. The membership meeting is formed by all the members and is the highest organ of power in UNIMA-CHINA.
- ii. Membership meeting is held once every four years.
- iii. The power of membership meeting:
 - a. Approve the working report of the standing committee and chief secretary.
 - b. Hear the report of finance division.
 - c. Decide on work plans.
 - d. Approve amendments on the constitution.
 - e. Handle resolution of the meeting.
 - f. Decide on naming of honourable member.

7. Board of Directors

- Directors of the China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society are the natural directors of UNIMA-CHINA. One director shall be elected for every ten UNIMA-CHINA members who are not members of the China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society.
- ii. Meeting for the Board of Directors is held once every two years.
- iii. Duties of BOD
 - a. To elect members of the standing committee and financial division
 - b. To elect Chairman, Vice Chairman, Chief Secretary and Deputy Chief Secretary.
 - c. To make work plans.
 - d. To organize working committees and regional branches.

8. Standing Committee

- i. The Standing Committee directs activities after the membership meeting. The President of UNIMA-CHINA chairs the Standing Committee.
- ii. Upon approval of the President, meetings of the Standing Committee are to be called by the General Secretary.
- iii. Meeting of the Standing Committee is to be held at least once a year.
- iv. Duties of the Standing Committee
 - a. To implement activity plans of the Association.
 - b. To handle reports and agendas received.
 - c. To approve annual budgets and supervise on expenditure.
- v. The Secretariat, lead by the General Secretary, is in charge of the operation of UNIMA-CHINA. Its main duties are international liaison and communication, organization of the work and finance of the Standing Committee.

9. Finance Division

- i. The Finance Division keeps the books of UNIMA-CHINA. The General Secretary manages the finance of UNIMA-CHINA in general. The Finance Division shall submit finance reports to the Membership Meeting.
- ii. The Finance Division consists of three members.

10. Regional Branches

- i. In provinces where needs arise for establishment of a regional branch, the Chief Secretary can appoint a local representative to organize the same.
- ii. The President of the Regional Branches is the Vice-President of UNIMA-CHINA.

11. Formal Name, Headquarters and Legal Person

- i. The formal name is UNIMA-CHINA.
- ii. The headquarters is in the Guangdong Puppet Troupe.
- iii. In legal matters, the President and the General Secretary are the legal persons to represent UNIMA-CHINA.

12. Funds

- i. Sources
 - a. membership fee
 - b. allocation of funds
 - c. income from activities and operation

13. Dissolution

- i. Proposal of dissolution must be passed by over two thirds of the Membership Meeting, and
- ii. approved by the headquarters of UNIMA.

Art Experiences:

I have been in the puppetry career for over 20 years since 1970. Since I have been in the present job in 1989, I organized the production of about 20 puppet shows of different scales. New plays such as "Wusong Defeating Tiger" and "Pingpong for Friendship"; and traditional plays such as "Dragon Dance", "Lion Dance" and "Puppet Riding" were praised in the country and overseas. A newly written play of Yangzhou characteristics, "Qionghua Fairy", won the award for "Outstanding Play" in the 2nd Jiangsu Province Art Festival 97 and was performed when reporting in Beijing in 97. Yangzhou Puppet Troupe had been to Japan for nine tours and performed over 1000 shows in over 400 cities in totally 44 months. It was also on performing tours, and enjoy success, in international art activities in Iran, Hong Kong, Australia, Russia, Hungary, the USA, Ecuador, Colombia, Peru, Bolivia and Pakistan.

In order to enhance the development of Chinese puppet and shadow plays and the exchange of puppet and shadow play arts between nations, the China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society now applies to join UNIMA.

China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society is registered with the Chinese State Council and is the only academic organization recognized by the Government to do national research and develop puppet and shadow plays. It now has 36 corporate members among 19 provinces and cities and 2000 individual members.

The China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society is willing to pursue peace, understand between races with puppet arts; to respect the basic human rights—stipulated by the "International Human Right Declaration" of the United Nations made on 10 December 1948; and to recognize the constitution of the UNIMA.

The China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society declares: there is only one China, i.e., The People's Republic of China. Taiwan is a part of China. After the China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society has joined UNIMA, it is the only lawful representative of Chinese puppet and shadow plays field.

The China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society recommends Mr LI Yuohao, Vioo Chairman of the Society, Director of Guangdong Puppet Troupe to be the liaison between China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society and UNIMA. The China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society will set up a special branch to handle affairs of China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society and UNIMA after the Society has joined UNIMA.

Minutes

The reporting meeting of the organizing committee of UNIMA-CHINA was held on 8-10 June 1997. YE Feng, Chairman of China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society; LI Yuchao, Vice-Chairman of the Society and person-in-charge of the organizing committee of UNIMA-CHINA; WENG Huimin, Chief Secretary; GE Chunfeng and PUN Zhicheng, Deputy Chief Secretary were present.

First, Mr LI Yuchao reported on the organizing progress of UNIMA-CHINA. Mr LI said that the decision of China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society to set up UNIMA-CHINA in Guangdong Puppet Troupe had been approved by Guangzhou City Cultural Department and was greatly supported by YAO Rongbin, Deputy Mayor of Guangzhou City. The organizing committee had purchased a van and communication equipment for UNIMA-CHINA. 60 square metres of the first floor of the newly re-renovated pleasure-boat was allocated as the office, reception room and conference room of UNIMA-CHINA. Deputy Mayor YAO Rongbin had also decided to set up a puppet art activity fund and that funds for major activities of UNIMA-CHINA would be allocated by the City Financial Division.

Mr LI Yuchao also provided attendants with copies of the approval of Guangzhou City Cultural Bureau on the establishment of UNIMA-CHINA in Guangzhou and photos of the office and van of UNIMA-CHINA.

Mr LI also proposed to hold an international puppet festival in Guangzhou in September next year. Attendants agreed unanimously.

Chairman YE, on behalf of the Society, thanked Guangdong Puppet Troupe and Vice-Chairman LI Yuchao for their great efforts in organizing UNIMA-CHINA; thanked Guangzhou City Government and Guangzhou City Cultural Deportment for their support in the establishment of UNIMA-CHINA. He commented the organizing progress as satisfactory.

The meeting reiterated that UNIMA-CHINA is in Guangzhou of which the establishment is handled by Guangdong Puppet Troupe. Mr LI Yuchao is the person-in-charge of the organizing committee of UNIMA-CHINA.

The meeting decided that UNIMA-CHINA would have two names. Internally, the name is External Liaison Office of China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society; externally, the name is UNIMA-CHINA. It was also decided that all formalities for application made by China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society of joining UNIMA were to be responsible by Mr LI Yuchao. As requested by UNIMA, the liaison between China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society and UNIMA in future is to be responsible by Mr LI Yuchao.

The meeting hoped that through the hard work of the organizing committee of UNIMA-CHINA, China Puppet and Shadow Play Arts Society can join UNIMA soon; and fulfill the long expected goal.
